UA students attempt to transfer over 9,000 courses among UAA, UAF and UAS each fiscal year. Many attempt to transfer multiple courses the same time. This repion testigates the nature of how courses have be transferred by undergraduate stude in this repion testigates among the three universities.

However, from a stude represent there may be remaining areas of dissatisfaction with the current transprocess. If a specific course has not been evaluated for transfer before, a student may need to provide the syllabus and submit a petition for the course to be applied to degree requirements. Information about the degree requirements successful se transfers are applied to is not readily quantified, for example whether course section apply to a general education requirement, respective, as a major requirement, or as an elective
